Accentuate the positive

Consider playing down the traditional Halloween emphasis on goblins, witches, and other scary characters and use this opportunity to participate with your children in healthy make-believe! (Adult participation with children in make-believe helps convey to the children an understanding of their world.) Children often spontaneously act out their secret wishes. At other times they are simply trying to find out what it would be like to be Dad, Mom, a fire fighter, or someone else.

Costume Planning

Carefully consider who or what you would like to be if you could be anyone in the world – modern-day hero, a historical character, or even a Mother Goose character. For example, emphasize *being* someone rather than *making* something. Use old sheets or garage sale clothes for costumes.
